Playtime Changes

We have made some changes to playtimes in order to try and improve behaviour, give children more space, ensure pupil safety and reduce the mess from the currently very muddy field.

- Years R-3 will now have a separate playtime from Years 4-6.
- All children will play on the playground, so they will **not** need to change their shoes (trainers/plimsolls are still needed for PE, sports clubs & adventure playround).
- We have increased the number of adults supervising the children at lunchtime and are trialling a system where each class plays in a separate area.

- We are also buying new toys and play equipment so there is a selection suitable for all ages. The lunchtime changes began this week and morning/afternoon break changes will begin on Monday. We will review the changes after a few week's trial to see how successful they are.
