School Improvement Focus – Handwriting

- Look back: the great thing about handwriting is that it is so visible. Look at a piece of writing from earlier in the year and make sure you praise your child for how much better their recent work looks!
- Continue to use letterjoin at home – ask if you need log-in details again.
- Encourage children to use their best writing in any homework they do and when practising their spellings.
