Over the next few weeks, we will be suggesting some simple games that you can play that require children to use thinking & problem-solving skills in order to win.


Some well-known games:

- Noughts & Crosses
- Connect 4
- Eye-spy
- Battleships

And perhaps a new one to some of you:

8. Dots and Boxes. This is a very simple game, suitable for the younger ones. Using graph paper each of two players taks turns drawing line 1 2 3

segments connecting two adjacent corners. The goal is to make boxes. The player who is able to make the most boxes wins. The game is easy to play and a little bit of strategy goes a really long way.
