Maths Problem Games of the Week

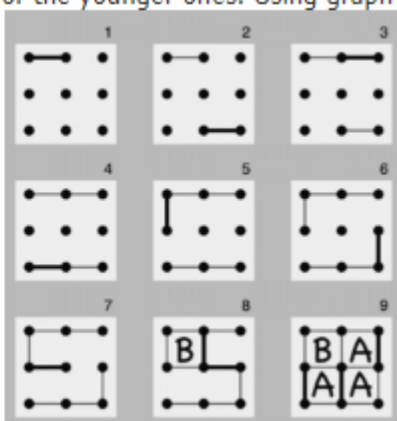
Over the next few weeks, we will be suggesting some simple games that you can play that require children to use thinking & problem-solving skills in order to win.

Some well-known games:

- Noughts & Crosses
- Connect 4
- Eye-spy
- Battleships

And perhaps a new one to some of you:

8. Dots and Boxes. This is a very simple game, suitable for the younger ones. Using graph paper each of two players takes turns drawing line segments connecting two adjacent corners. The goal is to make boxes. The player who is able to make the most boxes wins. The game is easy to play and a little bit of strategy goes a really long way.
