Good to Be Green

We are really pleased with our new behaviour system and are proud to report that the vast majority of our children are 'good to be green' most of the time. We wanted to make it clear that children who receive repeated red cards are not only at risk of a school exclusion, but will also be excluded from school events such as: school trips, after-school clubs, school disco, school sports teams. Whenever a child receives a red card, the class teacher talks to the parents about how to help the child with their behaviour. However, if their behaviour does not improve then they will lose these privileges until they can show that they can behave in a way that does not spoil it for other children. The complete behaviour policy (including the consequences at each level) can be found on the school website.

Premier Sports Clubs
