Grey, black or navy blue trousers
Smart shorts in grey, black or navy
Plain dark or white sports socks

#### **Uniform for Girls**

Royal blue school sweatshirt or cardigan
White or royal blue blouse/polo shirt
Grey, black or navy blue skirt, trousers, culottes or pinafore.
Blue and white dress or smart shorts in grey, black or navy shorts
Plain dark or white socks. Navy, black or grey Winter tights

### **Games and PE Kit**

Indoor PE/Games – Navy blue school PE shorts, blue, yellow, red or green school T shirt (according to House Team), plimsolls (slip-on for younger pupils) or clean lightweight trainers.
