




Can you finish these eater egg repeating patterns. Now try and design your own repeating Easter egg patterns.

## Phonics revision.



Can you practice your letter formation and remember the single sounds you have learnt so far? Perhaps you could have a go at writing the letters with your finger in shaving foam?


