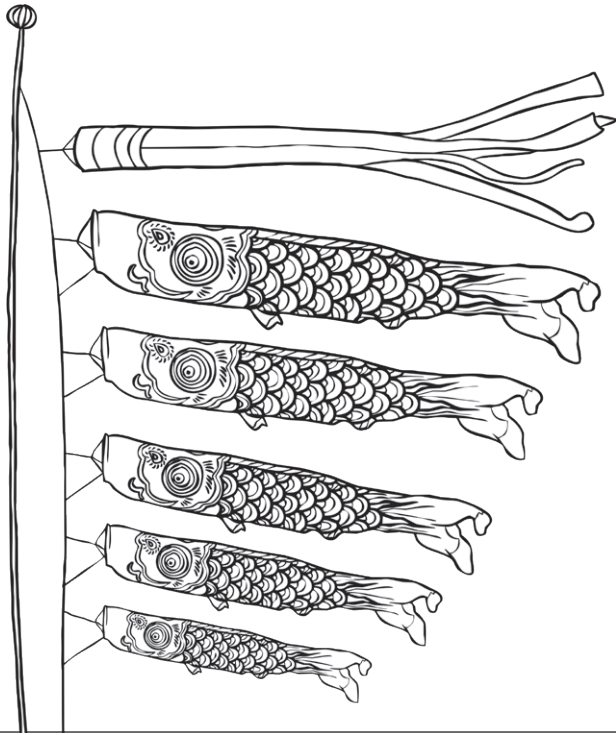


Make Your Own Toilet Paper Roll Koinobori

This simple cut and paste paper craft activity uses a toilet paper roll (optional) to create a simple three-dimensional Koinobori.



You Will Need:

- toilet paper roll (optional)
- tissue paper in a few colours (optional)
- crepe paper or ribbon
- single hole punch
- string
- colour pencils or markers
- scissors
- glue
- paper

Instructions:

1. Colour in your carp craft template pieces and then cut them out (eyes, fins and carp scales rectangular piece).
2. Glue the large rectangular piece on first to cover the toilet roll. If you don't have a toilet roll, just glue the edges of your coloured template together to form a tube.
3. Glue the eyes on either side of the tube.
4. Glue the fins on either side of the tube. You can place them wherever you think they look best.
5. Cut 10 to 12 strips of tissue paper or ribbon about twice as long as your cardboard tube.
6. Glue or tape the tissue paper or ribbon onto the cardboard tube on the opposite end from the eyes to form the tail.
7. Punch two holes, on opposite sides of the cardboard tube near the eyes and tie a piece of string to each hole.
8. Use your string to hang your carp up and fly it up high!
