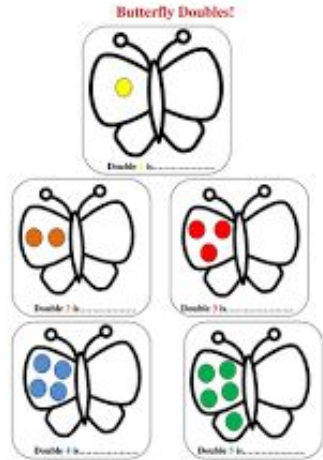


Reception

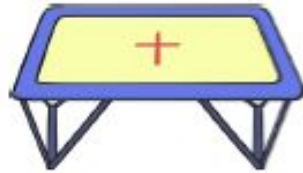

Maths Multiplication

What does the word multiplication mean?

When might you need to use multiplication in real life?

We use arrays to help us solve multiplication calculations. For example ,

5 rows 5 columns

$5 + 5 + 5 + 5 + 5 = 25$

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$$5 \times 5 = 25$$

There are arrays all around us. Can you find any in your home or while out on your walk. Can you work out the multiplication calculations to go with that array?
