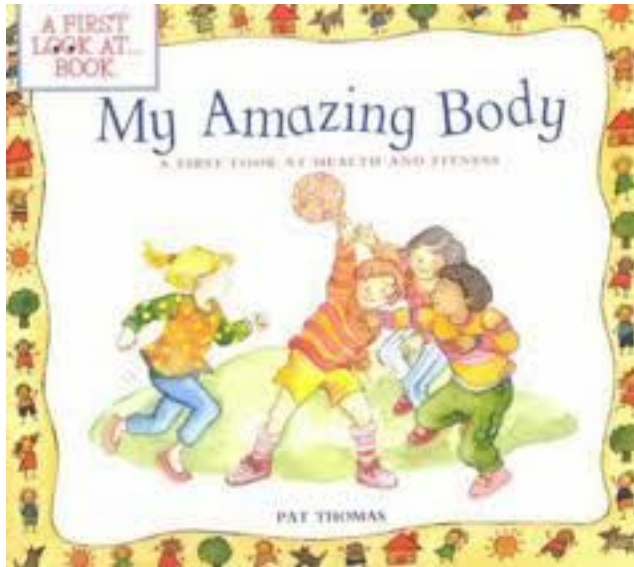


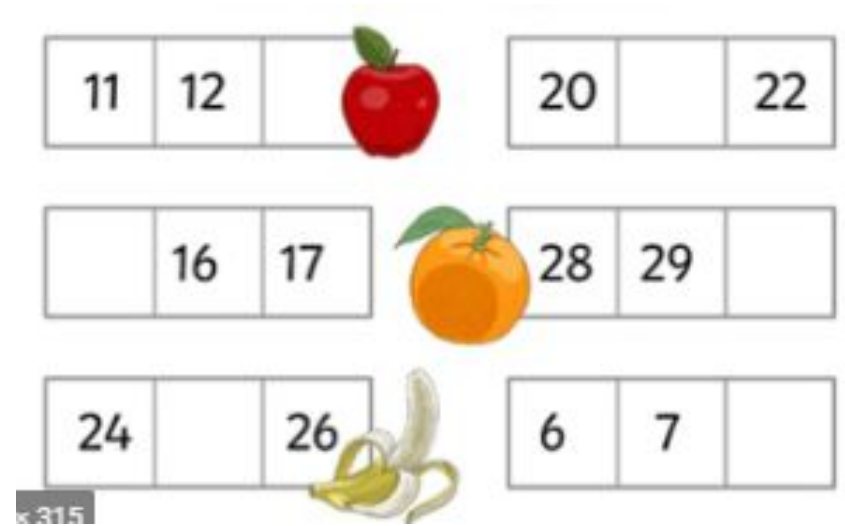

Now your turn. Investigate the different numbers of heads and legs with different combinations of chicken and sheep.

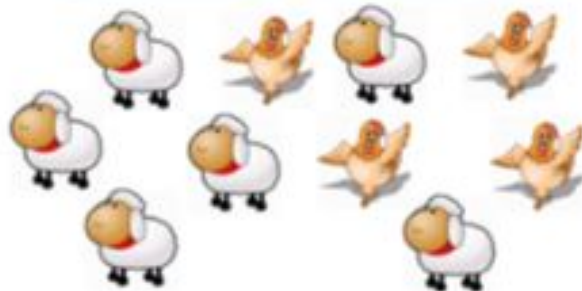

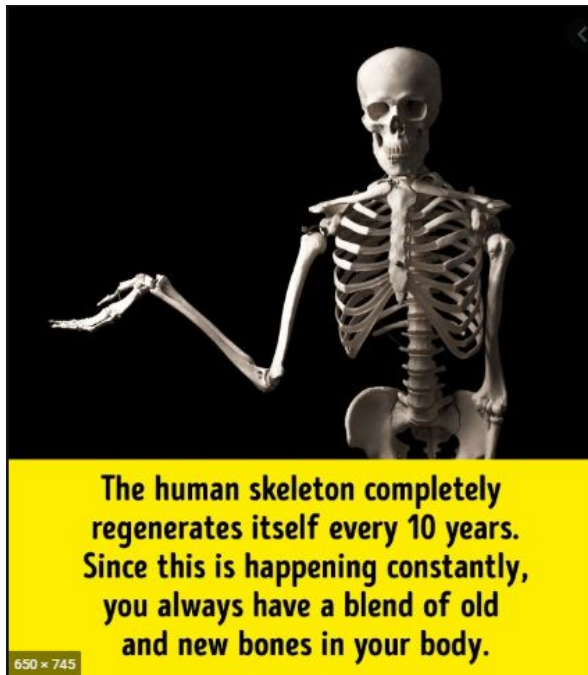
