




Today I would like you to have a go at writing your own List poem using the plan you made yesterday.


Give it the title Hello Summer!






Mental arithmetic

This week I would like you to focus on subtraction. This is a great game to play to help you with becoming more confident.





Using your knowledge Of shape chose one of these challenges to complete.


