Draw some pictures of the things that make you happy and write some words or sentences to describe why?



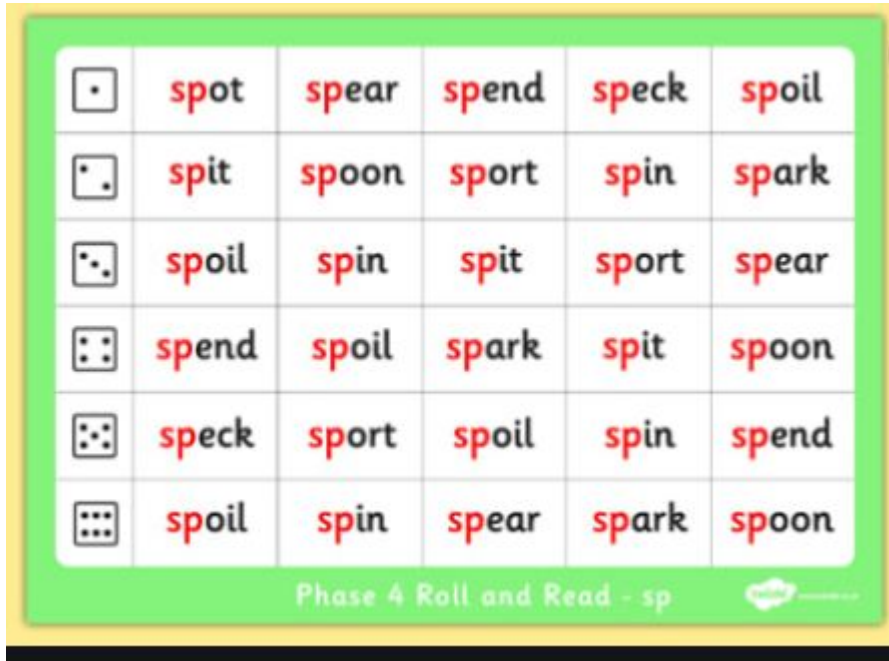
