
#### **Packed Lunches & Snacks**

We just wanted to clarify the rules regarding lunches and snacks. Children in years R up to 2 receive a free snack through the school fruit and veg scheme. Children in Key Stage 2 (years 3 up to 6) may bring a piece of fruit for morning snack if they wish. This should be fruit or veg only please.

There has been some confusion about whether children who have school packed lunches need to bring in additional food – they should not (apart from the fruit snack). Please either book a school packed lunch or provide one from home depending on what you & your child prefer.
