



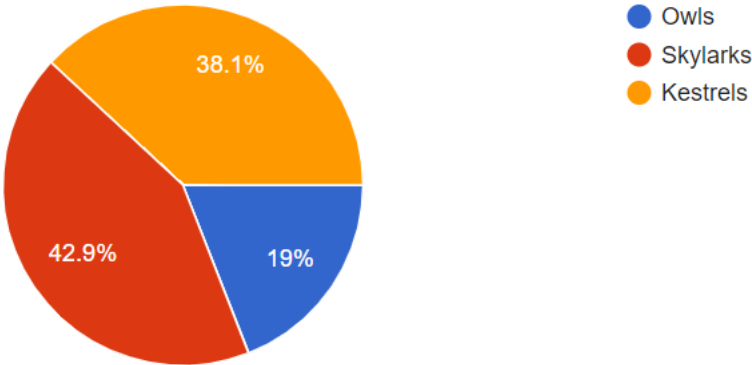
Parental Remote Learning Survey Results

21 responses

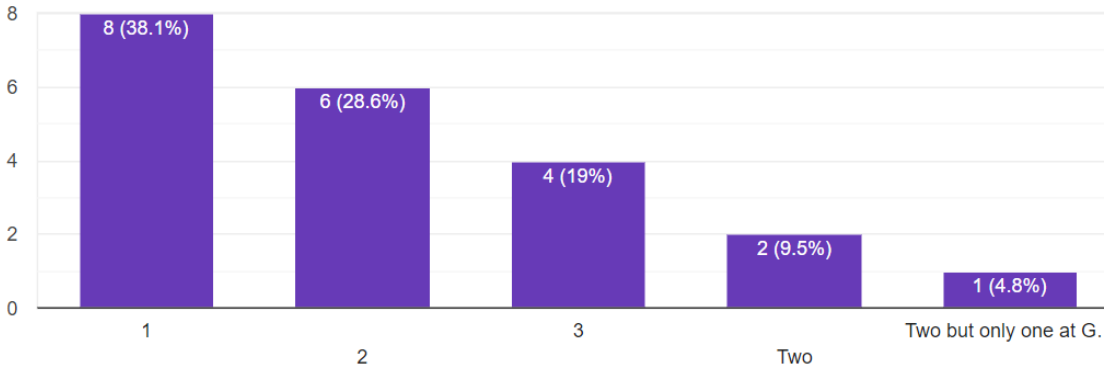


2) How many children do you have accessing home learning?

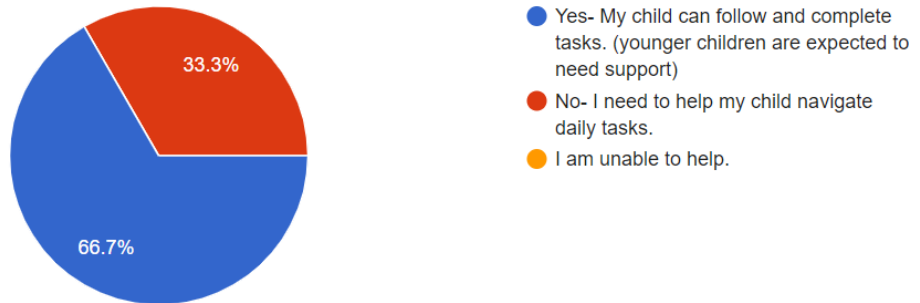


3) What type of device are you using to access Google Classroom?

4) Are the assignments set easy to follow?

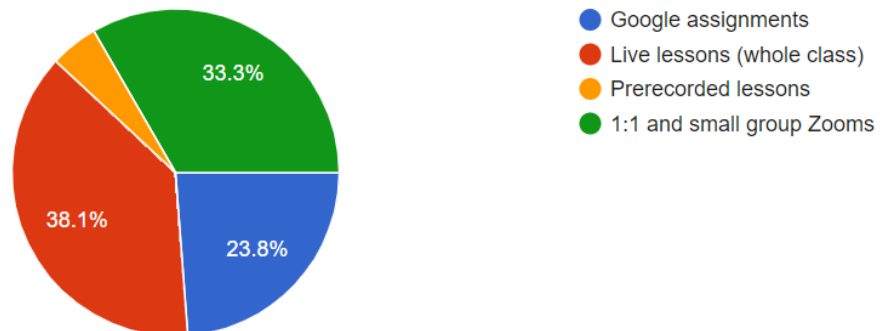

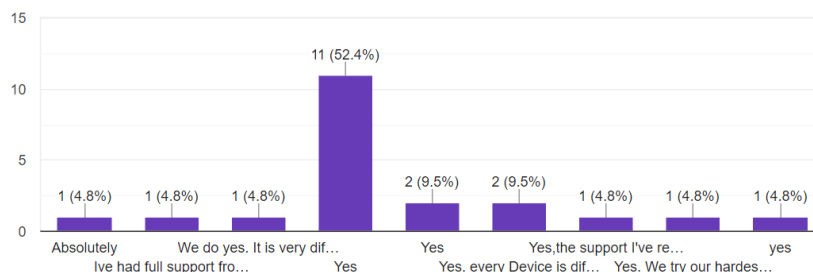


6) Do you feel you have had adequate support with accessing remote learning from school?

Out of 21 responses all said yes that they felt well supported by the school.

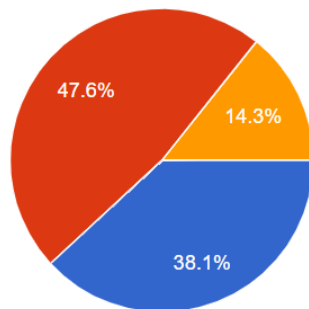
Do you feel you have had adequate support with accessing remote learning from school?

21 responses

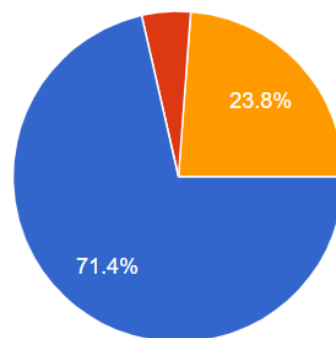


- Very- They are keen to complete all/most of their work
