Your class teachers will be in touch with P.E days and any class based information you may need.

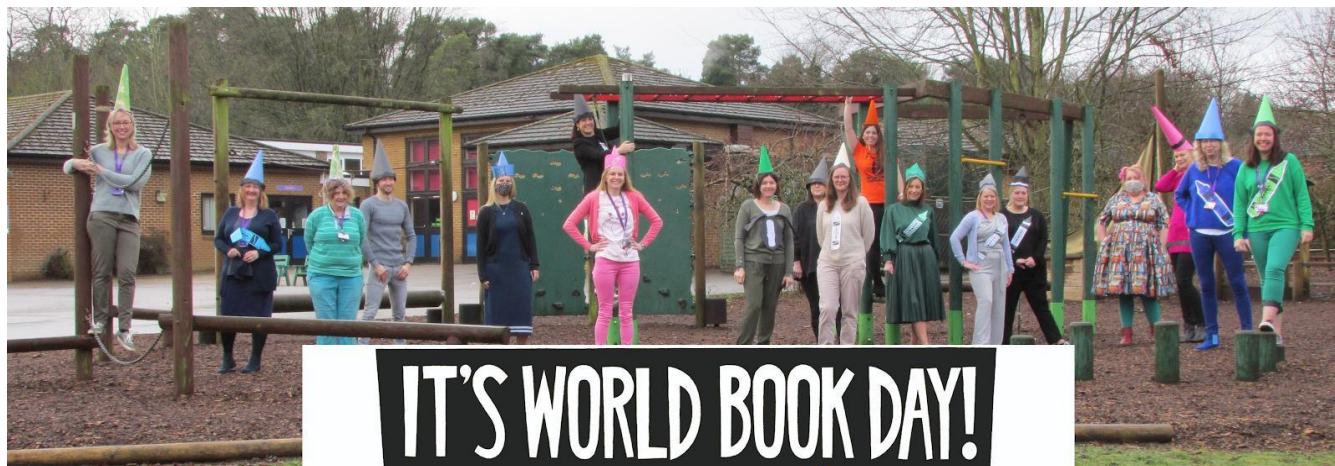
Have a wonderful weekend and we will see you all on Monday morning.
