In our English lessons, we're going to reading these stories by Steve Antony, and then having a go at writing our own versions!

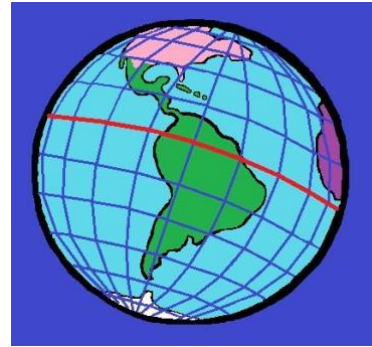


In our History and DT lessons, we're going to continue our Victorian clothing project, where we're going to be using our sewing skills to finalise our clothing! During our PATHS and PSHE lessons, we're going to taking a closer look at recycling and how our recycling habits impact our environment. We're going to be thinking about how some prouds in our households can be harmful if we don't use them properly. We're going to be delving in a bit deeper into the feeling 'worry'. We're going to think about special memories and how we can stay safe near roads as well as the many people who help keep us safe in our lives.



In Geography we're going to be learning about the equator and how it impacts on our ever changing weather! We're also going to be answering the question: Where would the Queen rather be? By looking at aerial photographs and considering whether or not the Queen would like to visit different areas in the UK and around the world!



In Science, we're going to finish off looking at animals from last half term and are going to be creating our own Hummingbird books, where we look at where they live, how big they are and what they eat!



After we've finished our hummingbird project, we're going to remind ourselves about all things trees, plants and flowers by answering the question What would the Queen have in her palace garden?



In Art, we're going to taking a closer look at portraits of monarchs, looking at colours, styles, backgrounds as well as how long portraits took when we step back in time! Then we're going to have a go at creating a portrait of Queen Elizabeth I. We're going to be using collaging skills as well as drawing and painting skills to create our portraits.
