







Key Vocabulary

This half term, our topic question is 'What do people do all day?' where we'll be looking at different jobs people do and the type of things these people do all day. Here are some words you might hear us talk about this half term, I've added a picture and definition to help you understand what they mean if you don't already know.

Job		A job is the work that someone does to earn money.
Work		When you work, you do the things that you are paid or required to do in your job.
Money		Money is the coins or banknotes that you use to buy things, or the sum that you have in a bank account.
Day		A day is one of the seven twenty-four hour periods of time in a week.
Career		A career is the job or profession that someone does for a long period of their life.
History		History is looking at and learning about events or people in the past and how they have shaped the world.



In English, we're going to be reading The Snail and the Whale, looking at the characters and the story behind it. We'll be learning how to write diaries and recounts in our writing lessons.

In Maths, we're going to continue learning about place value and numbers as well as looking at subtraction.



Music



This half term, we're going to be using our singing voices to perform songs. We'll also (fingers crossed!) be learning our songs for our Christmas nativity, watch this space!

French - Daily Routines

This half term, in our French lessons, we'll be learning about daily routines in French and seeing how they compare to the English translation.
