Everything you need to know about our EXCITING trip to Kidzania!

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are very excited about our upcoming trip to Kidzania in London on Thursday 20th January 2022 and we would like to say a HUGE thank you to the Friends of Gooderstone for paying for the transport.

Journey.

The coach will be leaving **Gooderstone at 7:30am** so we would like all the children in school at **7.15am**. This allows us to register them and also ensures that everyone has had that all important toilet visit before a long road trip.

The coach is expected to return between **6pm and 7pm**. We will send out a text when the coach is nearing home.

Sickness.

If your child suffers from travel sickness then please ensure that they have had their tablet prior to coming to school in the morning. If they require one for the way home, please contact your class teacher and they will administer it once you have completed the medical form.

What to bring.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch in a bag they can carry themselves (backpacks are ideal). We have a designated luggage area where we can leave coats and bags during our visit. We ask that the children do not bring glass bottles, sweets, fizzy drinks or chocolate in their lunch. As we are going for a long time so please pack extra snacks for the bus/day as they will be hungry.
