What is 2Go?

2Go is a program that allows you to

move an object around the screen using

either the arrows or by creating a simple

sequence of instructions.

Change the colour of the path that the object leaves in 2Go

Control the direction in which the object moves

In 2Go, you can either click on the undo button to go back one step or the rewind button to go back to the start of the challenge.
