Maths

In Maths we are concentrating on understanding whole numbers and exploring how those numbers are made. For example a 5 can be made using a 3 and a 2. We are using number blocks and building blocks to help us learn whole numbers and parts of numbers. We are always counting objects and recognising numbers. We have just purchased a new 100 bead number stick to help us count carefully.

Our phonic focus sounds this term are sh, ch, th, alongside all the other sounds we have been learning so far. We are focussing on segmenting for spelling and blending for reading. Expressive Arts

We are going to be looking at ways to create different textures and explore different sounds and patterns using xylophones this term.

We will be looking at patterns of fish scales and printing our own patterns, printing from real fish and adding different textured patterns into clay.

Understanding the World

Our focus will be learning about the oceans and seas and how important they are to us. Our starting point is the Recycle, Reuse and Reduce week where we will be learning about pollution and how we affect the world we live in.

Physical Development

This term we are going to focus on Gymnastics, using the benches, stools, ropes and large climbing frame looking at jumping and landing. We are also going to spend time learning some simple Hockey skills like moving a ball around a cone and passing it to a friend.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Each term we learn about our feelings during PATHS and PSHE sessions. We play turn taking games and talk about our different feelings and how to show our feelings in the right way to others.

Communication and Language

Our day always begins with a reminder of how to be a good listener and why it is important to listen to someone when they speak. We use P4C and Circle Times to work on turn taking when talking and sharing our ideas, and showing others we are listening by replying and adding to their conversation.
