From tiny acorns, mighty oaks grow



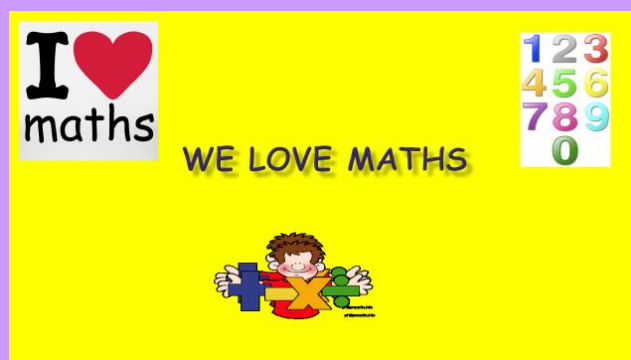
We are having a great time!
