Our learning- What have we been doing this week?

Owls: This week in Owls, we had our Science, Art & Writing Day (SAW) and we thought about Harvest. We wrote poems with a picture of a zoomed in cabbage for inspiration. We then did Science and made a chemical reaction using bicarbonate of soda and vinegar to make exploding apples! In art we used vegetables to print pictures.

Kestrels: This week in Kestrels, in our SAW day we discovered fossils in our school field. They were 60 million years old, we identified and classified them. We then made our own fossils. 
