## Phonics



We sing the alphabet every day at the start of our phonic focus sessions.

This term we are looking for the letter sounds f, l, ss, and j and will be finding objects and words that start with each sound.

## Expressive Arts and Design

This term we will be learning to explore the primary colours and will learn to explore colours by mixing their own.
