SENCo Information and Support

Working memory refers to the brain's ability to retain information. If a person is having difficulty with their working memory, they may need support with this task as they could forget the address while they are busy getting the map out. Working memory skills can be improved through consistent practice.

We want every child to be a confident reader with a passion for books.


Alongside our Power of Reading books, we also have a class reader which is a
