Welcome to our Acorn Newsletter!

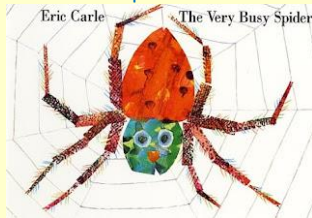
Here we are ready for Summer!

Maths

We will be learning to count objects, recognise numbers, especially the number 8 with our focus on Spiders!

Phonics



We sing the alphabet every day at the start of our phonic focus sessions.

This term we are looking the letter sounds v, w, x, y, zz, qu and ch and will be finding objects and words that start with each sound.

We are having a go at blending the letters to make words like

This term we will be learning to explore shape, making patterns and printing with different shapes.
