




Primary Maths Addition and Subtraction – Years 1 and 2




Write a number sentence for the picture below.



$$8 + 4 = 12$$

An addition fact is a calculation where we add a number to another number and work out how many we have altogether.

Write a number sentence for the picture below.



A subtraction fact is a calculation where we take away (subtract) a number from another number and work out what we have left.

Number Bonds

A **number bond** is a simple addition calculation. We need to learn our number bonds to 10 and 20. We can use these to derive (find out) related **addition** and **subtraction facts**.

For example: 13 + 7 = 20 20 - 7 = 13

7 + 13 = 20 20 - 13 = 7

and are **inverse** (opposite) operations (it undoes the effect of the other). We can check the answer to 12 + 8 = 20 by using the inverse 20 - 8 = 12 or 20 - 12 = 8

$$45 - 20 = 25$$

Addition can be done in any order (commutative).



$$9 + 5 = 14$$

$$5 + 9 = 14$$
