## Forest School Equipment: Can you help?

Mrs Cross, one of the teachers from Gooderstone is currently training to become a Level 3 Forest School Leader and is going to start delivering sessions to some of the classes here at Mundford. Forest School is a child-centred inspirational learning process, that offers opportunities for holistic growth. It is a long-term supports play, exploration and supported risk taking. It develops confidence and self-esteem through learner inspired, hands-on experiences in a natural setting. Children are given the freedom to explore and play at their own pace and follow their own interests.

In the spirit of reduce, reuse and recycle, we are appealing to our school community for some items that would help. Please see the list below and get in touch with the office if you are able to help in any way.

Some of the items needed include: ropes, tarpaulin, string or twine, tyres, planks, logs, branches, wooden cable reels, gardening gloves or metal pots, pans, spoons, buckets etc.















- Ropes to make swings, bridges, tarpaulins. This can be static or dynamic.
- Tarpaulins the more the merrier to keep us dry both over head and under foot.
- String, twine, paracord for tying and crafting.
- Tyres large or small but in good condition to be used for rolling, building, climbing.
  - Planks for building, making bridges and seesaws
- Wood chippings to make designated pathways.
- Wood Fire Logs we hope to build up a supply for when we are lighting fires and cooking.
- Tree Branches about adult height that can be used for den building and to designate areas
  that we want to preserve from trampling.



- Wooden cable reels ideally the large ones which can be used as a craft area or mud kitchen.
- Peelers and children's gardening gloves if you have any spare for whittling sticks.
- Metal pots, pans, spoons, buckets, trowels etc (not plastic please).


- We politely ask that all parents/carers keep their children with them whilst on the playground, at drop off and pick up.
