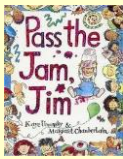
Maths

This half term we will be focussing on using comparing quantities to see which has more. We will also be exploring pattern with objects shapes and colour. We will be going outside to find different things we can a pattern in nature.



Literacy

Each week we have new books to explore and enjoy. We learn some new words and talk about them. We link then to the sound of the week.



Phonics

Our focus sounds this half term are ff, ss and ll at the end of words. We are also having a focus on using all the sounds we know to make c.v.c words like cat, sit, pop etc.
