# Owls & Goslings

This week in Owls & Goslings, have had a fantastic science week and have been excited by exploring plants and talked about why flowers are colourful. We also answered the question, 'Why do flowers have a stem?' by completing a capillary experiment using celery, water and food colouring. We also investigated different fruits with seeds.

# Skylarks

This week in Skylarks, we have explored lots of exciting science for science week. We dissected a daffodil, created floral collages and learnt about pollination. We also coded the new micro bits to log data about the plants and wildlife in our school grounds. Finally, we performed a magic trick putting a candle out without blowing on it.

## Kestrels

This week in Kestrels, we have absolutely loved Science week. We completed experiments about the three states of matter and learnt about how many substances can exist in all three states, including the wax of a candle. We then looked at the particles in a solid, liquid and gas, and saw how we could change the state of these by heating a substance such as chocolate.

#### Head lice

We currently have reoccurring cases of head lice in the school. In order to rid ourselves of these horrible pests we all need to work together to ensure that we are treating these cases effectively to stop the spread. It is really important that you continue to check your children's hair after the initial treatment even though many lotions claim to kill all eggs and lice in one go. It is quite common with these treatments for eggs to get left behind and once hatched the lice will once again breed and spread, nit combing daily will reduced the risk of this happening. As well as one off treatments there are some great products on the market which work as preventatives.


