### <u>Hazel bear</u>

When Hazel Bear is brought back to school, your child will have the chance to share their sentences and pictures with the rest of the children in the class.

Hazel Bear's first adventure will begin next week when we will select which child will take it home first!

## <u>Paths Pupil</u>

This year we will continue to have a Paths Pupil of the Day. This child will be the leader in our lines and will get compliments from the adults and children in the class. Your child will bring their compliments sheet home at the end of the day.

This year, children are able to bring something in for show and tell. Therefore, when your child is selected as Paths Pupil, they can choose one thing from home to bring in and show to the rest of the class if they would like to. Please do not send show and tell in on days when they are not Paths Pupil.

## <u>PE</u>

#### Our PE days are Monday and Friday.

Children are to come into school in their PE kits on these days but wearing their normal school shoes. A pair of trainers should be kept in school at all times for the children to use at break times and during PE sessions.

#### Homework

- **Reading** This is the main focus of what we would like you to do at home. We encourage you to hear your child read daily if you can. Regular reading will help your child to remember the tricky words and new phoneme they have been learning.
- Numbots- This is a website where children can practise their maths skills while playing a game. Children can play the game at home to help with their maths. We will give out certificates at the end of each week for those that have achieved a new level or have worked hard to improve their accuracy. I will send out their log in details this week, in case you have misplaced them.
- Homework books Children will bring home a homework book. Each Friday, children will be given either a piece of Maths or English work to complete. Please can this be handed in by the following Friday.
- The Big Question- I will set a question at the beginning of each half term. The children can answer this question in any way they like (art work, drawings, writing etc). This work should be handed it at the end of the half term.

English We will be focusing on 2 books this half term: Cave baby and Sidney, Stella and the moon. We will also have a big focus on handwriting and letter formation.	<u>Maths</u> We will start this half term by looking at place value. We will be looking at counting objects carefully and counting forwards and backwards. Towards the end of the half term, we will move onto addition and subtraction.	<u>Science</u> In science, we are going to be doing some investigations using different types of transport. We will be testing toy cars on ramps to see how far they will travel and investigating what makes a good paper aeroplane.
<u>History</u> This half term we will be learning about the first moon landing. We will start by looking at our solar system, before moving onto looking at rockets. We will end our space work by looking at the first moon landing.	Our theme this half term is "Journeys and Exploration".	<u>Art</u> We will be focusing on our drawing skills in art this half term. We will be creating self-portraits, looking carefully at where the features need to be drawn. We will then look at the work of Picasso and make our own versions.
DT In DT, we are going to be making moving space pictures. The children will be designing a space scene that will then have a rocket moving across it.	<u>RE</u> Our enquiry question in RE this half term is "What do my senses tell me about the world of religion and belief?" We will be looking at how the senses are used during worship and what images and objects are used to help with this.	<u>PE</u> On a Monday, with Mr Brotherhood, the children will be practising their ball skills. On a Friday, with Mrs Jermy, the children will be doing dance.
