Wrap Around Care!

Dear Parents/Carers,

We have been successful in securing funding for from the LA for resources to set up a breakfast and after school club. We are going to pilot this after half term to see if it is sustainable in the long term, for the pilot we be covering the days with existing school staff and will review this towards the end of the Summer Term. We will try to keep the service as affordable as possible (please note the minimum wage goes up to £12.21 as of April 2025) but the wrap around care facility needs to cover its costs to be viable. We will model the Gooderstone Breakfast and Afterschool club on the very successful Mundford one.

Capacity:

The service will run in term time only and will be available to a maximum of 10 children. We will be limiting the number of nursery places due to ratios and staffing requirements for younger children. In order to book sessions for nursery children please do this through the school office as you will not be able to do this over the Arbor App.

Costs and Times:

- Morning session: 7.40am – 8.40am £7
- Afternoon ½ session: 3.15pm – 4.15pm £7
- Full Afternoon: 3.15pm- 5.30pm £13

Booking sessions and payments:

You will be able to book sessions using Arbor App (the same way you book lunches). There will 10 slots available each day and this will on a first come first serve basis. The cut off for booking session will be 12am the day before. If you require emergency child care on the day, please phone the school office. Please be aware that there will be no refunds for any cancelled/unattended sessions.

Dropping off and picking up:

Children will be dropped off and picked up at the side door of Kestrels. Any messages for class teachers please ensure these are passed on through the class emails not the staff of the before and after school club.

Food:

Children will be offered a variety of cereals and toast during the breakfast session. In the afternoon session the children will be provided with a light snack (toasties, soup etc.) or you can provide your own from home.

Late Fees:

If you are running late, please let the school know as soon as possible. After 5 minutes, we will begin to charge you £1 per minute for every minute you are late to pick up your child. If you are consistently late to pick up your child the service will be withdrawn.

Behaviour:

Although before and after school club will not be a classroom environment, we expect children in it to maintain the behaviours required in school. A behaviour contract will be sent out to all children and parents that will be using our service. Any behaviours that consistently breach our policy/expectations will result in the services being withdrawn.
