This week in Kestrels, In art we have been researching the sculpting works of Antony Gormley. We had a challenge to mimic one of his sculptures using only paper! We found it very challenging and afterwards we discussed what materials would be better to use for sculpting. In science we have been learning about fossils, rocks and soils. We collected soil and dirt from different areas around school and looked into what each one is made up of.
