We will help you to let your light shine.	• Support our value-based education by encouraging my child to develop a positive, honest and respectful attitude towards our school community and beyond. • Support the school's behaviour policy and co-operate fully with any necessary behaviour procedures. • Send my child to school in a full school uniform. • Ensure my child attends school on-time, fed and ready for learning. • Notify the school of any sickness or other absence by 9am by phone or email. • Support the vision and aims of the school and help to let their child's light shine. • Conduct myself appropriately onsite and show respect for all adults working in the school. • Ensure all clothing is appropriate for wear on a school site- no inappropriate slogans. • Not ever be threatening, aggressive, use foul language, be unkind or act in a harassing manner onsite or towards staff offsite. • Not use social media platforms to air grievances against the school, parents, pupils, staff or any member of the school community. • Let the school know of any family or learning problems which may affect my child's learning or their behaviour. • Attend parents' evenings and support school events and activities. • Read with my child and write in the reading diary.
