Our Learning - Autumn 2

THEME: KNOWING YOURSELF

We will be exploring the theme of likes, dislikes and celebrate differences that make us unique. We will also explore feelings and friendships.

PHONICS

Reception will complete the full alphabet and begin learning some digraphs.

Nursery will explore early phonics including working on listening to sound patterns, rhythm and rhyme.

LITERACY

We will be reading our new story 'Look Up' where the children will meet Rocket who is obsessed with all thing Space!

MATHS

We will begin explore numbers beyond 5, and be investigating parts and whole. . We will sing, play games and explore in nature and while playing.

PSHE

We will be continuing to explore emotions and through our PATHS programme and be focussing on getting on and falling out.

What's New

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

We will explore bonfire night, Remembrance, Children in Need and other important events through the half term. We will also be answering the children's questions about space.

RE

We will learn about nativity and why it is important to Christians. Through our Music sessions we will also learn about other religious celebrations.

EXPRESSIVE ART & DESIGN
