Ofsted

Understanding the New Ofsted Changes

Ofsted has introduced a new way of reporting on schools. Instead of giving one overall grade like "Good" or "Outstanding," schools will now receive a "report card" that explains how they are doing in different areas — such as teaching, behaviour, inclusion and leadership.

The aim is to give families clearer, more useful information about what a school does well and where it is working to improve.
