This week in Owls we have had fun exploring our very own space station. Looking through the telescope we saw shooting stars and rockets. We thought about going on a space mission and wrote a list of things we would need to take. In maths the children have been investigating parts and wholes using objects and extending this by composing and decomposing amounts.
