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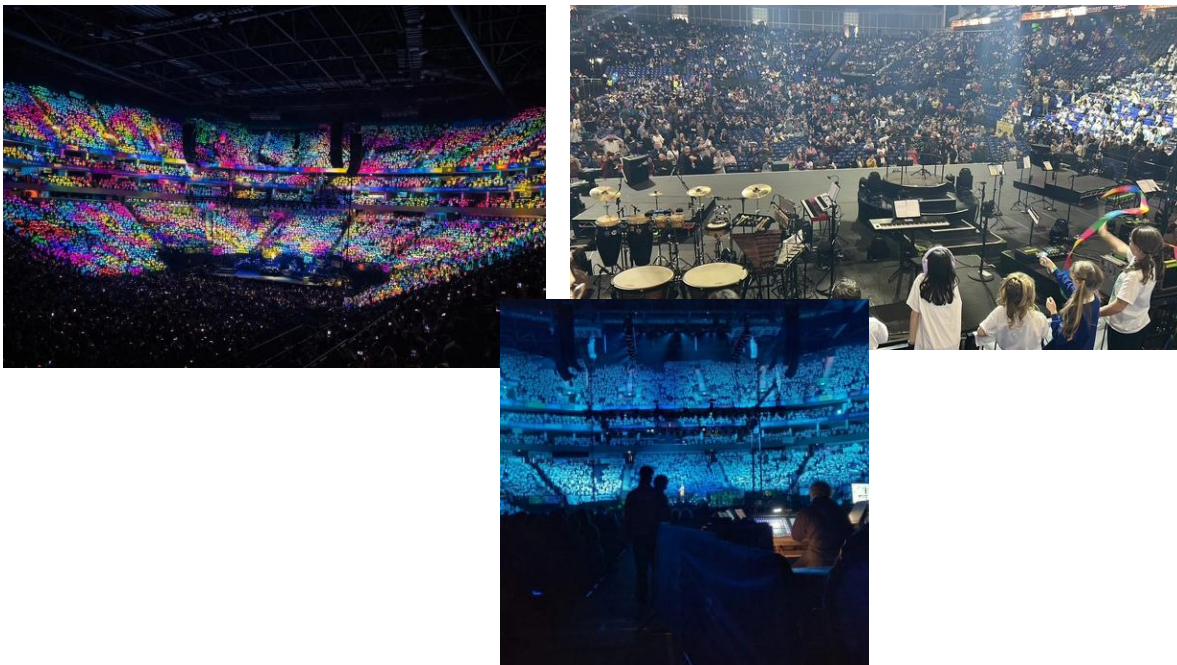

As part of our ongoing eco drive, we held a No Paper Week, where children were encouraged to explore their learning without using paper. Instead, pupils took part in a wide

Children learn in many different ways. Some learn best by doing, others by talking things through, moving, acting, building, or working alongside their peers.
