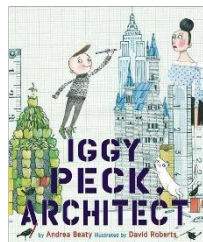


Summer Term 2

Imagination and Creativity

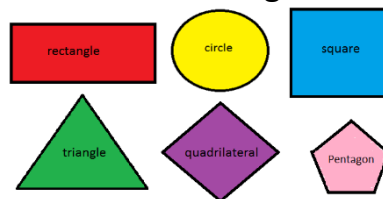
English

Our English book this half term is “Iggy Peggy, Architect”. We will finish the year writing fact files about interesting buildings.



Maths

We are starting this half term looking at 2D and 3D shapes. We will then move onto recapping our numbers bonds to 10 and 20 before looking at doubles.

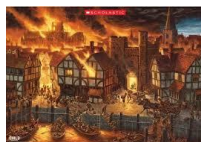


RE

Our enquiry question is “What do Jews remember on Shabbat?” We will start by looking at the Jewish creation story and introducing what Shabbat is. We will finish our learning by thinking about what we do to rest, and how that compares to Jewish traditions.

History

In history, we are going to be focusing on learning about The Fire of London. We will talk about how it started, why it spread so far and how London was rebuilt afterwards.

Art

In art, we are studying the work of Andy Goldsworthy. We will look at how he uses nature to make sculptures. The children will be collecting natural materials from around the school to make some pieces of art.



Homework

Reading- Read as often as possible.

Science

Our science topic this half term is ‘materials’. We will be naming and describing materials, and we will think about what objects are made from different materials. We will finish the topic by testing different properties of materials and learning about recycling.
